

## **Andrejsala celebrates the International Architecture Day**

On 1st October, SIA Jaunrīgas attīstības uzņēmums contributed to the activities of the International Architecture Day in Rīga, an activity that this year focused on the subject of Transmitting zero CO2 emission architecture.

First, at the planning office of SIA Jaunrīgas attīstības uzņēmums, there was a retrospective of the milestones of the Riga Port City project, which included information on the area surveillance and creation of the core concept carried out by Office for Metropolitan Architecture (OMA, a Dutch architect firm), the Andrejsala zoning proposal by SIA Colliers International, the analysis of visual impact by SIA Forma as well as the results of the recent study titled "Lifestyles and Values of Rigans in 2020".

Visitors were offered the most up-to-date edition of the Andrejsala detailed master plan and the proposed building outline in the form of mock-up models, maps and visualisations.

The exploration of the future Andrejsala and Rīga will continue at a multimedia exhibition in Andrejsala, organised jointly by the Rīga Municipal Architectural Bureau and Jaunrīgas attīstības uzņēmums, on 5th October. It is also intended to provide the wider public with more information about the past, present and future of Andrejsala during the traditional Andrejsala "nameday" festival, which is celebrated on 30th November of every year.
